CONDITIONS

THIS WARRANT

- I. Is not valid unless all the particulars are correctly shown and unless it bears the official stamp of the Ministry of War Transport.
- Ceases to be valid if there is any change in the name, flag, or ownership of the vessel. Any such change must be reported by the owner or agent immediately to the Ministry of War Transport and a new warrant asked for if required.
- Ceases to be valid in the case of a vessel on time-charter at the expiry of the time-charter.
- May be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Minister of War Transport.
- Should be kept by the Master of the vessel in his own custody and shown by him whenever he desires access to commercial shipping facilities under British control.

6. Should be returned by registered post to the Ministry of War Transport if the vessel is in a United Kingdom port when the period of validity has expired. If the vessel is in a British port overseas, it should be submitted for extension to the local Customs Authority, and if in a foreign port to the British Consular Officer.
